1.Information

2.Command Line

Command line interface is very useful for project automation and batch processing. The detail as following:

2.1 Parameters for command line interface

Parameter	Explanation
-files filepath [...]	Specifies a list of files to operate.
-input dirpath	Specifies directory, in witch the all files be operated. This parameter and “-files filePath[...]” parameter can exist.
-encrypt	Do encryption.
-obfuscate strict specialitems	Do obfuscation, followed by two other parameters: strict: Whether to use strict encryption mode, true or false; specialitems: The special string items, witch you do not need to obfuscate. Comma separate. Such as: -obfuscate true methodName1,methodName2.
-watermark text location	Add watermark, followed by two other parameters: text: The content of watermark. Simple HTML is support; location: The position of watermark. The value should be one of RT, LT, RB, LB and CENTER.RB is default.
-output dirpath	Specifies the directory to save the files.
-exit true false	Specifies whether to exit application after files are all operated.

2.2 Some samples for comman line interface.

a.Specifies a file to encrypt and obfuscate

```
-files d:/desktop/draw.swf --encrypt --obfuscate false --output d:/desktop/done
```

b.Specifies multiple files to encrypt and obfuscate

```
-files d:/desktop/draw.swf d:/desktop/ty.swf --watermark "copyright by laan" CENTER  
--output d:/desktop/done
```

c.Specifies a directory to encrypt, and do not exit application

```
-input d:/desktop/myswfs --encrypt --output d:/desktop/done --exit false
```
